As previously advertised, Sarah Cobb, from Hampshire's Primary Behaviour Service, will be running two parent information sessions on Thursday 23rd November in the Infant School hall. These will contain the same information and will be from 2.00pm - 2.55pm in the Infant hall and from 6.00pm - 6.55pm in the Junior hall so that we can, hopefully, enable most parents to attend.

Sarah introduced the 6 Strands to us at the start of the term and we have been exploring ways that we can best use them to support the children to develop their learning behaviours in class. We believe that the knowledge that she shared with us about the way emotions can affect our behaviour and responses to situations or events is invaluable.

Sarah is an excellent, knowledgeable presenter who uses the approaches she describes and the content of the 6 Strands on a daily basis in her work with children. We really hope that you are able to join us for one of the sessions in order to find out more about how we are working to support your children and to take a closer look at the resources that we are using.
